- You have a good reason or reasons why you can't use H-Barracks for night-time only parking for your vehicle.

The OVO parking citation must be issued under **San Diego Municipal Code § 86.0139(a)**– **Prohibition of Parking of Oversized Vehicles, Non-motorized Vehicles, and Recreational Vehicles**.

This Oversized ordinance states in relevant part:

Except as provided in section 86.0140 or otherwise expressly provided to the contrary herein, or unless such parking or standing is authorized by the City Manager and appropriate signs permitting such parking or standing are posted:

(a) It is unlawful for any person to park or leave standing upon any public street, park road, or parking lot, any oversized vehicle, non-motorized vehicle, or recreational vehicle between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 6:00 a.m.

OVO tickets cost \$173.00. They are different from the "Violation of Signs" tickets that are based on signs restricting parking such as at parking lots in Mission Bay prohibiting any size vehicle from parking between 2:00 a.m. to 4:00 a.m. Violation of Signs tickets are not covered by the Settlement.
